- ❖ School records, including information or a signed release form for The Classical Academy to obtain them. MEAP scores must all be 1 or 2, a **grade point average of 3.0**, and other standardized tests must be 75% or above.
- ❖ Citizenship marks must be all 1 or 2. Include a discipline report.
- ❖ Available times for an interview if the selection committee would like to meet with you.
- ❖ Turn in application to The Classical Academy's office, first floor at Central High School.
