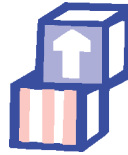

### HEAD START

- Tuition-Free to eligible low income families
- Kindergarten readiness program for 3-5 year olds
- Includes children with diagnosed disabilities / delays
- Parent activities and parent involvement
- Nutritious snacks & lunch provided daily
- Vision, hearing and dental screenings and services
- Half and full day sessions available, Monday - Thursday
- Teachers with Early Childhood Degrees

### M.S.R.P. (Michigan School Readiness Program)

- Tuition-Free preschool services, income is not a factor
- Kindergarten readiness program for 4 year old children at risk
- Monday - Thursday; full day sessions
- Vision, hearing, and dental screenings
- Parent activities and parent involvement included
- Certified teachers with early childhood training
- Nutritious meals offered daily

- Targets low income parents with young children, 0-7, Tuition-Free
- Family literacy focus with parent education and parent/child interaction
- Offers adult education and/or GED
- Includes transportation, incentives and field trips
- Includes early childhood education / child care as needed
- Home and center based activities
- Connects families with community resources

### SKIP TO A GREAT START (Successful Kids = Involved Parents)

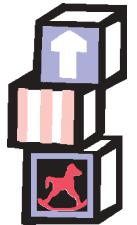
- Tuition-Free parent education and parental involvement program
- Focuses on early literacy and preschool readiness skills in children
- Targets families with children 0 - 5 years old
- Hearing, vision, dental and developmental screenings included
