QUALIFICATIONS:

Education: Master's Degree required. Michigan license as physical therapist required.

Experience: Field placement working with students with disabilities.

Skills: Provides and coordinates physical therapy services to students assigned to his/her caseload.

Works directly with students in a prescribed treatment program.
Completes assessments and necessary paperwork.

Other Requirements:

Newly hired employees must satisfactorily pass: 1) physical examination by a medical doctor; 2) police clearance; 3) reference check, including digital fingerprinting; and 4) 5-panel drug test. Must comply with Student Safety Initiative Legislation, as amended.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS:

Conducts physical therapy evaluations of students suspected of having a disability or of special education identified students through the referral or Multidisciplinary Evaluation Team (MET) process.

Provides and coordinates physical therapy services to students assigned to his/her caseload.

Attends MET and Individualized Education Planning Team (IEPT) Meetings when requested.

Develops individualized annual goals and short-term instructional objectives for students in the caseload as per physicians' prescriptions.

Maintains appropriate student records.

Employs physical and mechanical treatment methods.

Coordinates the activities of and instructs the physical therapist assistant and/or aid if one is provided.

Consults with staff, parents/guardians, physicians and others regarding physical therapy services and adaptive equipment.

Assists staff and students with adaptive equipment needs.

Drives to and from different assigned buildings.

Represents the district on various community services agencies and professional organizations, as appropriate, to the assigned area.

Performs other related duties and responsibilities as assigned or as appropriate.

The information contained in this job description is not an exhaustive list of the duties performed for this position. Other duties within the classification and the physical demands of the job may be assigned.
