QUALIFICATIONS:

Education: Must meet State of Michigan Teacher Certification guidelines with a Vocational Endorsement in an appropriate area OR be eligible for Vocational Certification (BA with 2000 hours current and relevant experience) OR Annual Authorization (4000 documented hours of paid employment in a current and relevant position; must agree to pursue a State recognized teacher Preparation Certification program of study at a recognized teacher preparation institution; must take classes towards teacher preparation degree requirements on a continuous basis).

Skills: Must document current and relevant experience and training in the performance of Medical Assistant duties and responsibilities.
Documented knowledge of related medical office computer technology including current medical insurance billing software and practices.
Medical Assistant Certification.
Demonstrated customer/patient relations abilities.
Must believe that all students can learn.
Must be a relentless pursuer of visual imaging technology.
Must demonstrate a capability to plan and implement instructional activities.
Must demonstrate the capability to working a team setting.

Use of vehicle to visit clinical sites is required.
